



## DOE Public Hearings on the Illinois SSC EIS

### A Reminder

As part of the final selection process for naming the preferred site for the Superconducting Super Collider (SSC), the U. S. Department of Energy will be holding public meetings on the Draft SSC Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) in all seven states on the final siting list. The purpose of these open meetings is to solicit public comment on and proposed corrections to the EIS in each state.

The two-day public hearing on the Illinois Draft EIS will be held at Waubonsie Valley High School in Aurora at the intersection of Eola Road and Route 34 on:

- Thursday, October 6, 1988, from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., and
- Friday, October 7, 1988, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon, 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., and from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Fermilab staff members may exercise their rights of free expression and assembly by attending these meetings in whatever capacity they choose, either as observers or to read a statement into the record.

However, staff members who elect to attend the hearings during regular working hours are reminded that they cannot do so as paid employees of Fermilab. In the event you wish to attend during regular working hours, you must either take supervisor-approved vacation or unpaid leave for that day or days. ❁
